- Thousands of individuals around the state might be losing healthcare coverage, and we need your help spreading the word.
- Effective August 1, 2015, HUSKY A income limits for parents and caretaker relatives were reduced from 201% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL) to 155% FPL.
- Household income limit for children remains unchanged at 201% FPL.

Who is Impacted?

- Up to 14,000 parents and caretaker relatives with household incomes above 155% FPL

What are we doing to help?

Access Health CT, the Department of Social Services, the Office of the Healthcare Advocate and the of Policy Management, partnered to develop the outreach plan below:

- Live outbound calls
- Sessions with community organizations e.g. hospitals, health advocacy groups etc. to contact and inform the impacted population.
- Posters in strategic areas
- 7 Enrollment fairs with Application Counselors, Brokers, and Access Health CT Customer Service
- 60 and 30-day written notice and a postcard
