

Math & Reading Tutors Wanted

The *Bridgeport Caribe Youth Leaders* seeks friendly and hardworking tutors for its Math & Reading Tutoring Program for students in grades 3 through 8.

About Caribe Youth Saturday Academy:

The Math & Reading Tutoring Program is part of the Caribe Youth Saturday Academy. Our vision is to provide the environment, resources and inspiration for all our students enabling them to improve their skills and understanding of Math and Reading.

The small tutor to student ratio provides targeted assistance to meet the students' needs and at the same time ensures high quality curriculum regardless of the students' economic background.

Program Specifics:

The tutoring program begins September 23, 2017 to November 18, 2017. Classes will be held on the University of Bridgeport Mandeville Hall campus on Saturday mornings from 8:30AM to 12:30PM. The program will be dedicated to math instruction, reading comprehension and an enrichment segment. There will be a break in between sessions for both students and tutors.

Tutors will be required to demonstrate the ability to teach math and reading in an engaging manner. Class sizes will average 3 students per 1 tutor. The Caribe staff will provide tutor training and teaching materials before the start of the program so that tutors will be successful in teaching the curriculum.

Tutors must be able to commit to the 2 training dates (tentatively set for the weeks of September 11, 2017 and September 18, 2017) as well for all the Saturday morning sessions. The schedule for the Saturday classes is:

Week 2: Saturday, September 30, 2017 (8:30AM to 12:30PM)

Week 3: Saturday, October 7, 2017 (8:30AM to 12:30PM)

Week 5: Saturday, October 21, 2017 (8:30AM to 12:30PM)

Week 6: Saturday, October 28, 2017 (8:30AM to 12:30PM)

Week 7: Saturday, November 4, 2017 (8:30AM to 12:30PM)

Week 8: Saturday, November 11, 2017 (8:30AM to 12:30PM)

Week 9: Saturday, November 18, 2017 (8:30AM to 12:30PM)



Tutor Requirements:

We are looking for tutors that are highly motivated, flexible, and reliable individuals who have strong communication skills and a passion for helping students succeed.

Tutors should:

- Be self-motivated, responsible, friendly, hardworking, and professional.
- Have the potential to motivate and connect with grammar school students. *Prior experience working with grammar school students is a plus.*
- Be comfortable speaking in front of a small group of grammar school students.
- Be highly skilled in the areas of math <u>and</u> reading, writing and grammar. *Math, Teaching, English and Engineering majors are strongly encouraged to apply.*
- Be excellent communicators both with their students and with the Caribe staff.
- Possess impressive academic backgrounds. *A GPA of 3.0 or higher is preferred but not required.*
- Be able to attend all required tutor trainings, all Saturday classes (from October to November) and debrief meetings with the Education Director
